Together, we believe this initiative will strengthen both local communities and the national economy.

I respectfully urge you and your colleagues in Congress to:

- Support administrative and legislative measures to **accelerate Employment Authorization Document (EAD) approvals** for humanitarian parolees;
- Consider **temporary automatic work authorization extensions** for those awaiting renewal;
- Recognize the critical role these newcomers play in our **local economies** and communities.
